Competitive fixtures and leagues should feature your strongest team and regular school club attendees, some of these fixtures may lead to county wide events or competitions.

Friendly tournaments should feature, as much as possible, those children that take part in clubs at school but have not been chosen for the competitions in that sport or may struggle to access opportunities outside school. Where there are only friendly fixtures for a particular sport, please rotate the children you bring to each fixture as much as possible. We will not be collecting scores for these events.

We Can Play and inclusive events are aimed at those pupils who face barriers to participation in physical activity for any number of reasons (such as SEND, gender, low social economic groups, ethnicity or low self-confidence). They will have not, or very rarely, attended clubs (in or outside of school) or represented their school before and the aim is to inspire and encourage these children to become more active. The events will include a range of skills, activities and small sided games related to a specific sport with a focus on fun and positive experiences.

For friendly and we can play events, we recommend that all squad members take part in every game and they are rotated so all participants have equal playing time

VENUE INFORMATION AND PARKING ARRANGEMENTS

Taunton College

Parking is only accessed via Heron Drive off Silk Mills Road. You need to register at the meter and pay £1 or use the parking app. There is a 20 minute window in any hour for dropping off/picking up. **NO PARKING at Castle School.**

King's College

Please enter via the big gate at **TA1 2EY** (Holway Road, opposite the Flying Horse pub) and swing immediately left. Having parked, please walk along the path by the astro pitches.

Please enter via Kingston Road **TA2 8AA**, follow the signs to park in the designated areas and walk to the top fields.

Ash Meadow

Located at The Convent Field, Taunton, TA1 3QE. Drive past Taunton Deane Cricket Club, through the gates and park on the field.

Richard Huish College

South Road, Taunton TA1 3DZ. Details to be sent nearer the time.

Taunton Rugby Club

Veritas Park, Hyde Lane, Taunton TA2 8BU. Parking is available on site.

St Georges School

The Mount, Taunton, TA1 3NR. Parking is available on site - details to be sent nearer the time.

Wivi Pool

The Recreation Ground, Wiveliscombe, Taunton TA4 2TA. Parking is available on site.

Taunton Vale Sports Club

Gipsy Lane, Taunton TA2 6LL. There is now ANPR (Automatic Number Plate Recognition) in place. You need to register and pay £2 at the pay station within the car park via contactless payment, credit or debit card. There is also an app that can be downloaded. A 20 minute window to allow for drop-off and collection is allowed for without the requirement to pay to park. Should a vehicle complete a drop-off within a 20 minute window, it can return later to collect, and will be able to stay for another 20 minutes free of charge.
